E. Kilpatrick survey

Surveyors are not agreed upon its lo-
cation, and I think a re-survey will
be ordered in the near future, I have
done much private work on the Ber-
gara & Kilpatrick surveys and think
they should be located with tolerable
accuracy, judging by work done
by a former surveyor, secondly by
an observation which I made on
J. F. Smith's House at St. Mary's, call
for from the S. to. Cor of this Survey.
and thirdly from the fact that the
4 Northern surveys - 1st Gilland.
2nd Lockhart, 3rd Carper & 4th Hollis
were surveyed in this location pro

ceeding the help. E. The Lake
calling for the S. boundary line of
The Hollis - The Kilpatrick
is survey No. 12. This break is
caused I presume by the nest
surveys being made on the coast
and elsewhere returning the co-
location to this survey - You may
note that the calls of the Bergara
and The Osseuden, are bothward
indicating the Northern surveys to
precede them, since I think they
are not likely. (The Kilpatrick in
particular) to be pressed northward
for lack of Land - but I have
little doubt of their being consider-
able ex. v. vacancy adjoining
The Larger Paup survey. and the
J. J. Williamson fractional fraction
al survey, L. S. # 34. These surveys
are younger than those before men-
tioned. and closing them up in
drapping. would necessarily have
the effect of crowding the Kil-
patrick or Bergara surveys. ~~It~~
