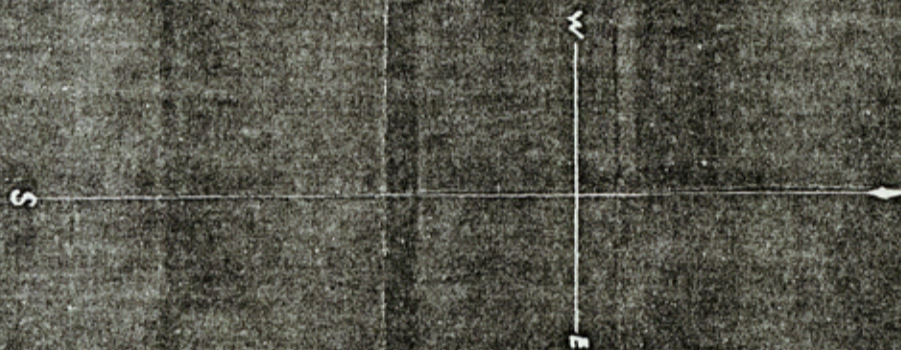

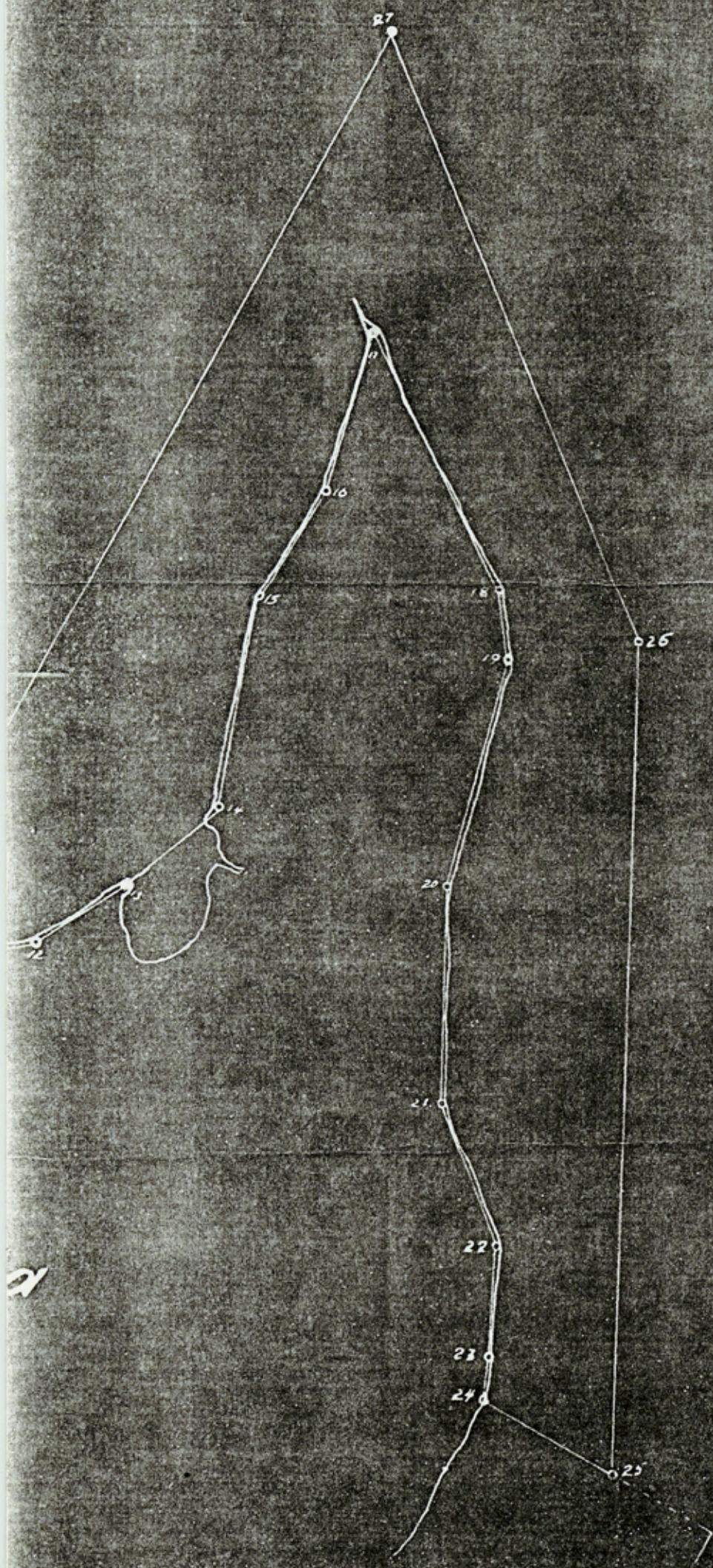

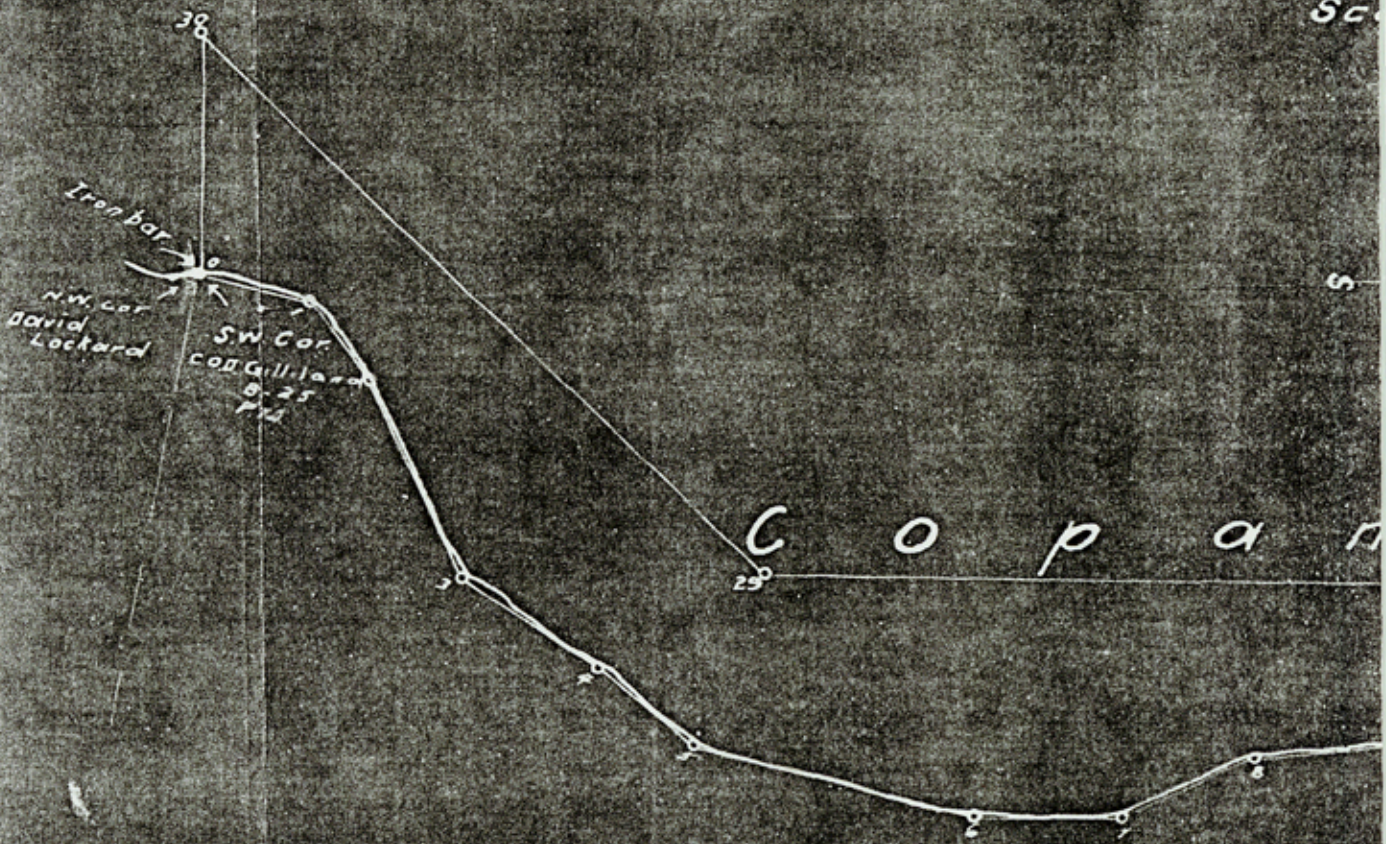

FIELD NOTES of a Survey of ¹⁹⁶208.24 acres, made for John H. Traylor in accordance with his application for Oil and Gas Prospect. Application Surveyors number 110. and being made under and by virtue of Sections 3 and 4 Chapter 83, Act approved March 16th 1917.

Said Survey being situated in Copano Bay on Live Oak Peninsula a about 4 miles N from Rockport . the county seat.

Beginning at the N.W. corner of the David Lockhard Survey on Live Oak Peninsula, and the Waters of Copano Bay .

An iron rod driven in the beach and from which a 7" Mesquite bush marked two hacks bears S 74°50' E 13.7 varas and another Mesquite bush marked three hacks bears N 51 1/4 E 19.8 varas and the Copano

House ruins bears N 53°45' W and a small island bears N 25° 1/2 W
