Shoreline Boundary Survey Report

The upland tract being surveyed is described as:

BEING A 10,643.041 ACRE TRACT OF LAND, OUT OF LOTS 6,8 & 10, SECTION 46, LOTS 1 & 3, SECTION 49, FIFTH SUBDIVISION OF THE TAFT FARM LANDS, A MAP OF WHICH IS RECORDED IN VOLUME 1, PAGES 46 & 47, OF THE MAP RECORDS OF ARANSAS COUNTY, TEXAS AND ALSO RECORDED IN VOLUME 2, PAGE 39-C, OF THE MAP RECORDS OF SAN PATRICIO COUNTY, TEXAS, A REPRINT OF SAME RECORDED IN VOLUME 4, PAGE 47, MAP RECORDS OF SAN PATRICIO COUNTY, TEXAS, AND BEING OUT OF FRACTIONAL SECTION 46, LOTS 2,4,5,6,7 & 8, SECTION 49, ALL OF SECTIONS 52, 56, 58, 59, 64 THRU 73, 75 THRU 78 AND PORTIONS OF SECTION 81, SIXTH SUBDIVISION OF THE TAFT FARM LANDS, A MAP OF WHICH IS RECORDED IN VOLUME 1, PAGE 50, MAP RECORDS OF ARANSAS COUNTY, TEXAS AND ALSO RECORDED IN VOLUME 2, PAGE 33-A, OF THE MAP RECORDS OF SAN PATRICIO COUNTY, TEXAS AND BEING ALL OF THOSE CERTAIN TRACTS OF LAND, DESIGNATED AS TRACTS 1 AND 2, AS DESCRIBED IN VOLUME 137, PAGE 239, OF THE DEED RECORDS OF ARANSAS COUNTY, TEXAS AND BEING ALL OF THAT CERTAIN 945.14 ACRE TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED IN VOLUME 507, PAGE 253. OF THE DEED RECORDS OF SAN PATRICIO COUNTY, TEXAS, ALL SITUATED IN AND OUT OF SAID SAN PATRICIO AND ARANSAS COUNTIES, TEXAS.

The eastern boundary of this property adjoins Puerto Bay State Submerged Land Tracts 1,2,3 and 4. The southern portion of this shoreline survey overlaps a previous survey submitted to the General Land Office and filed as "Aransas County Rolled Sketch No. 5".

A Mean High Water (MHW) level was established by observing a staff gauge, at the site for a period of seventy-two (72) hours and comparing the results with Operative Base Network Control Station, designated NOAA 87745131, located at the south end of Copano Bay State Fishing Pier. This station is also designated by the Conrad Blucher Institute as "Copano Bay" ID No. 036. The elevation of MHW was established as 0.2 feet, NAVD 88, by running levels from NGS vertical monument F 603 RESET (third order), which has a published elevation of 7.7 feet. This is an adjusted value from a superseded elevation of 8.2 feet, NGVD 29.

The subject shoreline is approximately five (5) miles in length and has multiple characteristics. The shoreline is predominantly a vertical cut bank approximately eighteen (18) inches high and this bank was used as the shoreline where it occurred. There are isolated stretches of variable height bank with sloping beaches. Also some areas are wide sloping beaches subject to inundation and covered with aquatic vegetation. The shoreline on the latter locations was established by elevation 0.2 NAVD 88.

Artificial fill covers a portion of the Puerto Bay Submerged Tract 3, where an existing bridge crossing for State Highway No. 188 is located. The limits of this fill are outlined on the survey plat provided. This fill area exists without benefit of an existing easement from the General Land Office. I am also submitting under separate cover a survey of both shorelines affected by this bridge crossing. This second survey is being conducted for the Texas Highway Department in accordance with requirements for application to lease the submerged lands affected by the bridge, if needed.



Artificial fill has been placed over portions of the Puerto Bay Submerged Tract 3, where an existing bridge crossing for State Highway No. 188 is located. The limits of this fill, as digitized from Texas Department of Transportation aerial photos of State Highway No. 188, are outlined on the survey plat provided.

Based on a search of General Land Office records, the fill area appears to exist without benefit of an existing easement. I am also submitting under separate cover a survey of both shorelines affected by this bridge crossing. This second survey is being conducted for the Texas Highway Department to determine right-of-way acquisition requirements from both the General Land Office and the adjacent upland owners.
