a Survey of some of the
Archer when in the Counties
Beginning at the N.E. corner of
Survey No. 2616 made for the Texas Cattle
and Land Co. which corner is on
the West side of a small branch near
a soap spring known as Backbone Spring
N.B. at this corner I found one of
the bearing trees - a Mesquite,
standing marked T. F. L. C.
Hence I run West 1344 vs the
and no evidence of corner.

Hence West about 400 vs a branch
across N.E. at 1344 yards.

Hence West, at about 1000 vs a branch
at 1344. bearing trees not to be found

Hence West 1344 vs to the N.W. corner
of No. 2619 made for Texas Cattle & Land Co.
found one of the bearing trees standing

Hence North at 2000 yards branch
across N.E. and runs into Post Oak Creek
at 3800 vs branch crosses N.E. at 5700 vs
a branch at 14050 vs branch East at
this point Post Oak Creek is about 1
mile to the East. at 15600 yards branch
on which camped for the night, - at
18160 yards crossed Little Post Oak
at 21060 yards Margin of Little
Wichita. Station No. 1, Counter # 13637

Beginning at Station No. 1 on the bank
of Little Wichita. Thence East 1800
varas to Post Oak Creek near the mouth

Beginning again at (No. 1)
Thence S. 64° W. 1840⁰ S. 74° W. 2860 vs
N. 58° W. 1360 vs to a Oak, 2560 varas
to the margin of Little Wichita (No 2
(at Ranger Camp)

Beginning at (No 2), Thence
S. 45° W. 440 varas, N. 43° W. 120⁰ across
Little Wichita. N. 70° W. 600 vs. West of
Mouth of Onion Creek to S 25° E
600 varas - Thence N. 45° W. a
2500 vs. high ground branch 2000 vs
to the right. 9200 vs across a tra-
verse North South, at 14,500 vs rocky
hill - good building rock -
at 17,600 varas in sight of Holiday
Creek, at 24,200 varas Holiday Creek at
24,400 varas and changed course
to West, at 360 varas to an Elm tree
marked F. This tree is bearing for
a corner on the West line of Fitzgerald
640 acres survey and is 100 vs N. 11°
E from said corner which is in the
center of said W. line - Station No 3,

Beginning at Station No. 3
Thence North, at 7,000 varas North
slope of hill, at 12, (2) 00 varas to
the margin of Big Wichita River
and Station (No 4)
