Survey of 640 Acres, the Elm witness tree  
to which, being found and identified -

Thence South 437 1/2 m

Thence East 529 1/2 m stake point marked  
"C" on map hereto attached. Beginning at the  
N.W. cor Jm Taylor Survey No 24, the mesquite witness  
to which is still standing & plainly marked -

Thence East 950 m the NE cor said Taylor No 24,

Thence South 1900 m the SE cor said Taylor No 24,  
a diligent search here failed to discover the  
witness trees called for at this corner -

Thence South 1344 m the SE cor Jm Taylor No 26  
(nothing found by which to identify this corner)

Thence South 1500 m the SE cor of Aaron Cas.

Thence West 3973 m the NW cor Fair County  
School Land. (The mesquite witness tree at this  
corner can not be found) Set Rock in  
ground for corner. Thence South at 353 m  
the stake marked "C" on map above described,  
in all 2999 m. at stake -

Thence West 3961 m. creek bank

The position of line then showed that <sup>to produce it</sup> only  
one crossing of the Creek would be obtained  
whereas the Fred notes of Wm H. H. H. the Sur

calls for three crossings of creek - a thorough examination of the timber up & down the creek, revealed no marks by which the original Smith boundary line of Wm Hainsworth could be determined. The meander of creek also showed that my position was too far north, not giving me but one crossing of the creek. The least offset south that would give me 3 crossings, I found to be 38 m. & also to increase this offset more than 45 m. would give me only 2 crossings (one bend of creek being missed entirely) I determined therefore by offsetting 38 m. I would be as close to the original position of Smith boundary line of said Wm Hainsworth - as it would be possible to determine - Hence continued as follows: at 3761 m. - offset South 38 m. Thence continuing course west at 3894 m. Creek, at 3956 m. Creek - in all 5278 m. - set Rock for the SW Cor. Wm Hainsworth Survey -

Also Beginning at the S.E. cor. sur no 2420 J & H Co. which is readily identified by calls in original field notes of said no 2420 survey. Thence at 2688 m. the NW Cor. sur no 2438. J & H Co. Thence East 5145 m. Thence South 1078 m. Thence East 320 m. the above described Rock set for SW Cor. Wm Hainsworth Survey -
