

Beginning at a rock mark, whence thence bearing 6° due
bearing N 28 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 185 rods 3 prong, do. 6° due N 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 155 rods the same
being the S.E. cor. Sur. no 5 in Blk G. 5 Thence w. at 1344 rods
an old stone and the S.W. cor. of said Sur. no 5; at
1403, the N.W. cor. of Sur. no 85, same Blk a pile of stones
in deep arroyo, at 2688 rods a large pile of round flat
rocks. The S.W. cor. Sur. no 6, same Blk at 3825 rods a stone and

^{as called from Field notes} hill which is a Thence W 344 rods a stone and on not quite

& perfectly agree as to course & distance, with all the
old corners on both sides of the roadway south of them]
Thence w. at 960 rods cross Tres. Canyon, at 1900 rods a large
stone and on top of and at S end of round red hill
in valley. Thence N 450 rods a stone and the S.E. cor. Sur. no
55 in 13 Blk G. 2. D&P Ry Co. Thence w 1080 rods a large stone
and in the L in valley at foot of long divide in S line
said Sur. no 55. Thence N 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ 40 rods a stone and on
E point of Plains on N edge of bluff. the S.W. cor. Sur. no
1. Blk A. 1. G. + M. Thence E 1900 rods a stone and its S.E. cor.
Thence E 1900 rods a flat stone marked X on top of divide
from which large cedar post, bearing N 89 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 216 rods a stone and
at jump off, on roadside first bearing N 85 E about 350 rods the
same being the S.E. cor. Sur. no 2. Blk A. 1. (These two
corners of Sur. 1. 4. 2. Blk A. 1. are correct for I checked
around them and found both the S.E. cor. of them as
described in field notes)

Field notes of connecting lines made for Land Office Oct 19th 1902,

beginning at a Gypsum mt in trail on E Bluff bank of river thd same being the S.E. cor. of Sur. no 49. Blk 41. Thence W. 4678 vs a point. Thence S 55°6' vs a cedar post marked J.A. The E. cor. Sur. no 43 Blk 41. I find this correct as sketch from L^e Office shows.

Then beginning in River bed 40 vs N of S. bank from which Gy. Mt on top of bluff brs. N 20 W. 380 vs thence N 16°59' vs a point in River bed. Thence E 1464 vs a rock from which Hackberry 10" in dia brs N 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 450 vs large Gyp. sh. brs N 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 450 vs, Thence W 3633 vs a pt. Thence N 37°2' vs The E cor. Sur. no 37~~1~~ Blk 42 which lacks a very small amount of being the same as the fieldnotes of 121. & 120 Blk 46. will show, if we consider the extreme rough ground. Then I began at the E cor. of 37. Blk 41. which is a large mt. mt. on side of hill and measured E, 4110 vs. & N 1587 vs to a stone marked X whence cott. 3 ft. India mrd X brs S 11. E 80 vs it being the S. W. cor. Sur. no 39. Blk 41. I also measured around Sur. 39. & found N. W. cor. of 40. & the N. W. cor. 114 Blk 46. as described in fieldnotes & found these corners even all up & agreed with each other. I did not make the connections around sur. no 11. Blk 46. because the vacant land was already approved & sold.
