Field notes of connecting lines made for Land Office Oct 19th 1902,

beginning at a Gypsum mt in trail on E bluff bank of river the same being the SE cor. of Sur. no 49. Blk 91. Thence W. 4678 vrs a point, Thence S 556 vrs a cedar post mtd S.A. the E. cor Sur no 43 blk 91. I find this correct as sketch from Lt Office shows.

Then beginning in River bed 40 vrs N of S. bank from which Gyps. Mt on top of bluff brs. N 20 W 380 vrs Thence N 659 vrs a point in River bed, Thence E 1464 vrs a rock from which Hackberry 10" in dia brs N 73 1/2 E 450 vrs large Gyp. sh brs N 69 1/2 E 450 vrs, Thence W 3633 vrs a pt. Thence N 3702 vrs the E cor Sur no 37 ~~0~~ Blk 92 which lacks a very small amount of being the same as the field notes of 121. & 120 Blk 96. will show, if we consider the extreme rough ground. Then I began at the E cor of 37. Blk 91, which is a large m. mt. ^{mtd x} on side of hill and measured E, 4110 vrs. & N 1587 vrs to a Stone mtd x whence cott. 2 ft india mtd x brs S 11. E 80 vrs it being the S. W cor Sur no 39. Blk 91. I also measured around Sur 39. & found N. W. cor of 40. & the N. W. cor 114 Blk 96. ^{as described in field notes} & found these corners were all up & agreed with each other. I did not make the connections around sur no 11. Blk 96. because the vacant land was already approved & sold
