I Enoch Moore Deputy County Surveyor Atascosa County do. Certify that by actual  
Measurement On the Ground, I found the East End of the Granbury Williams Survey No 526  
plainly Blazed or marked, that the two North Eastern Corners are in Open ground there being no  
trees near. The North N E corner bears S 44 1/2 W 640 rods from the west corner of the  
Dunbar. The ~~South~~ <sup>West corner of Dunbar</sup> corner is also in Open prairie no trees near. The west corner  
of No 466 is in Prairie no trees near. The Measurement has been made from the Smith  
Survey No 949 as represented on Sketch and actually measured On the Ground.

The Original Corners of the Jno Bryan and No 336 are the ones from which I made  
the other surveys ~~and connected~~ <sup>to say</sup> that is, No 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12.  
Connecting them with survey No 1483, 1299, and 1724 and No 1300.  
<sup>as shown in sketch</sup>

I believe the Shully does not extend further S 50 W than the 95 rods  
called for from the South Corner of said No 466, as there is some small  
Mesquit Bushes in about the place of the said west corner of Shully  
Given under my hand at Office in Pleasanton this 2<sup>d</sup> day of  
April 1877.
