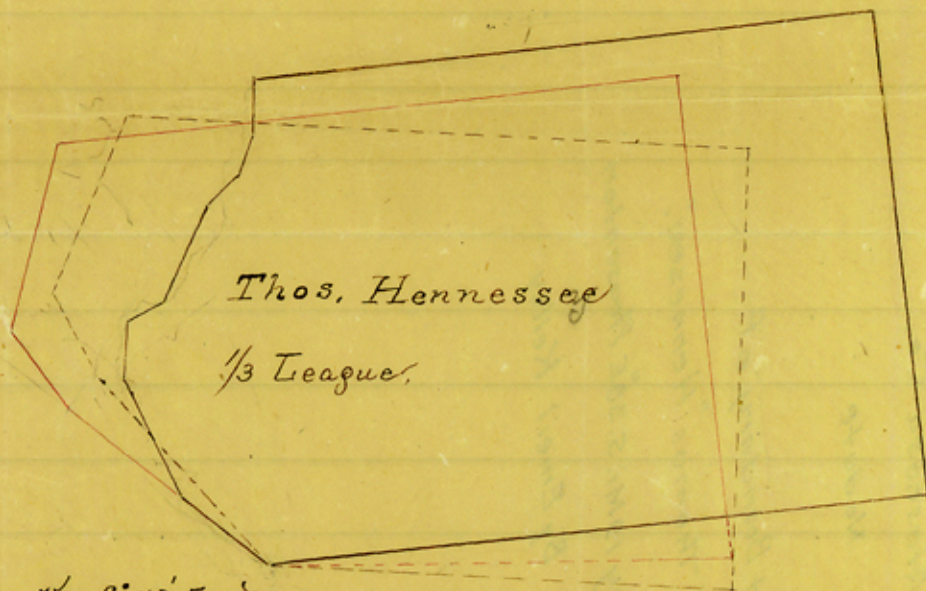

Scale 1000 vs. Via, 8° 40' East.

In a survey of the above the west boundary of the Thomas Hennessee (the Atascosa Creek) was meandered as follows, to wit. Beginning in the channel of the Atascosa Cr. the upper corner of the Edward O'Boyle - Thence up the creek with its meanders = N 50° W. 569 vs. = N. 24 1/2° W. 685 vs. = N. 3 1/2° E. 293 vs. = N. 63° E. 207 vs. = N. 25° E. 566 vs. = N. 47 1/2° E. 226 vs. = N. 20° E. 215 vs. = N. 3 1/2° E. 296 vs. = These lines were run and measured to a perpendicular distance equal to length of back line called in Original Title. The original calls for creek line will not follow the creek but leave it and run out on high ground as shown by Red lines, the dotted lines show original calls run magnetic, but neither will follow the creek, It seems to me that the rule that it is lawful to reverse a survey would hardly be applicable in this case, as it would make such a great difference in acreage, any suggestions that you might make

to enlighten me on this subject will be
thankfully received.
