

Pleasanton Jan'y 18th 1876.

Now James B Shaw Dear Sir Enclosed herewith I forward you the corrected field notes of the work on the Lagunas connecting said Survey with those of Austin & Williams also field notes for other surveys with their Alternates I have carefully prepared them and balanced this work so as to be certain of their correctness. You may think it hard to have so much trouble with this work, but I do assure you that the fault is not entirely my own for I have in most cases found all of the old lines either too long or short for instance the Survey on which Pleasanton is situated I find by a careful measurement to be 3163 varas from East to West when the field notes call for 3008 varas & 3008 varas S 3008 west & 3008 varas North and the distance ~~is~~ it is 3080 varas Those lines are all run at right angles and is a smooth Country to measure in. The Survey on the N West of this Survey is another that compares well with those old surveys in this County it calls for a few ~~varas~~ over 1300 ~~varas~~ and measures 1670 ~~varas~~ with those as a sample of the Old work is it possible for a Surveyor to make his work fit exactly and run for miles in prairie before he can find a Surveyor's mark? I readily answer No! This is not the worst for I find some surveys wanting in length and as we must bend to the situation I do it cheerfully and will call for all of those lines when I find them. I believe you want this work through I do most sincerely & to wind up all of those surveys last located I have located 5 Sections on the County line of Atascosa & Frio Counties adjoining those surveys of yours in SW cor of this County. I have made these surveys out if they suit you I will have them recorded in Frio County and Record them in this County. Those surveys are of excellent black land with some sand in them about as rolling as those on the head of Little Walnut Creek N E of Austin with ~~out~~ a prospect of a good stone quarry on the SE Survey I shall of course await your answer. Jan'y 29th.

On this Morning I received your favour of the 14th inst. with the report of Mr J Shultz for which I am thankful. I know that there

in some of these surveys that was formerly made by the original Surveyors & joining them largely of yours.

I will be able to make the required Explanations in a few days. I know you are anxious about this work and I have no hesitation in saying that you shall be entirely free from this care very soon. I am in doing all that may possibly can be done to get this work through Correct and to the interest of yourself & the Co. Be patient a few days and I will send the work in in a corrected form. I herewith send you a plot of two surveys on the Lajunies I believe ^{to be} that it is correct and corrected field notes connecting the said work to those surveys on the San Miguel. This work I found by actual survey from their old corners. and you can rely on the connections given in said field notes.

July 22. On Yesterday I received your favour of Duplicate Cert. No 462. And field Notes returned for correction. I herewith transmit them to you - By the next mail from this place I will send you a plot or sketch with your work on South of Williams East of Watsons and North of the Sanchez with a full explanation of their connection which will not change the County Map materially in the Govt. Land office. The measurement of the E Blines of Williams. U.S. Patm ¹⁷⁰⁸ Jan 5 1802 on the Section N. 50 E. to the Survey made for Campbell is 1920 ft. Then N 50 W 37 ft on then N 50 E 116. ft to S cor of Coleman then N 41 W. 2328 ft then N 50 E 1133 ft then N 40 W 1608 ft. to the beginning the lines which are ~~then~~ in the former beginning. The corners of the Dumbas & Williams are on as shown on map. but the lines appear to be to short off the Dumbas and Coleman by 17.5 ft & 40 ft. I made this statement from facts but of course you need have no fears.
