I, J. H. Walker, Chief Clerk and Acting Commissioner of the General Land Office of the State of Texas, having been requested by letter dated March 28, 1910, addressed to J. T. Robison, Commissioner of the General Land Office, signed by W. M. Abernathy, County Judge of Atascosa County, to designate the center of Atascosa County, do hereby certify that I have, from the map of Atascosa County, the surveys of that county, and other data on file in this office, ascertained the geographical center of said county, and do hereby certify that upon the official map of Atascosa County it is a point within the limits of the Galba Fuqua Survey No. 1181, of 192L acres, having been patented by No. 270, Volume No. 7, one hundred and thirty (130) varas south of its northern line and sixteen hundred and fifty (1650) varas east of its western line.
