Coleman survey) no corner found, Thence N 40 W 2928
vs placed a stone, (no trees near) for west corner of
said Coleman survey - Thence West 6450 vs to E B line of
No 526, - Thence South 1516 vs to its S.E corner (no bearings
found: but line marks, for East & South lines of said tract)
Thence West 440 vs meet at creek, at 1373 vs the N.E corner
of survey No 1708 a Live Oak with 13 vs N 82 W 1350 vs - Thence
South 1900 vs (no marks) - Thence West at 914 vs N.E corner
of No 1713, (old bearings found) Thence South at 2236 vs found
S.E. corner of same (old bearings) - Thence S 45 W at 1880 vs

Thence Beginning at said stone round the East corner of N^o 76 - S 40 E 2600 vs - S 72 E at 3000 vs Atascosa creek at 5590 vs Lepan Creek, at 7520 vs said N. E. corner of Ed O'Boyle.

N.B.: The corner of A Burton No 1330, described in the foregoing, was located according to existing lines and N.E. corner of the W.S. Thornton Survey (old bearings on the ground) - from N.E. corner of said State Sec No 74. Good L.O. trees were found, marked on S.W. sides, as for S.E. corner of No 708. about 160 vs S.W. from same.

For connections of surveys up the Metat Creek - Begin at said West corner of the John Coleman Survey - Thence N 38 W 5830 vs S.B. line of survey No 7, of Pointmont - Thence West 39 vs S.W. corner of same (old bearings found) Thence North 2050 vs N.W. corner of same. Thence West 590 vs S.W. corner of Aho - a P.O. Pro N 23 1/2 W 20 vs - two small P.O. Pro N 89 1/2 W 13 vs - Thence West passing stone corners, at distances called for in Field Notes, 1900 vs point - at 2013 vs Metat Creek, at 2120 vs an old line. *Survey No 720. N. Cross Metat Cr.*
