I submit to you a corrected map of Sec. 190 of free school land, showing the subdivisions made by me after the correction of the same. I actually runned the lines of said Sec. 190 from where the S. W. line of Wm Gammel's  $\frac{1}{3}$  lge, crosses San Bernard (A), all round to the lower corner (G). And in order to ascertain the correct location of John Allens 320 Ars. survey, I began at its N. corner (H) in Colorado County, established by the Surveyor of said County and acknowledged there as the correct corner, a post; thence I runned at the proper bearing and distance to the E. corner, which I found to be at I, not at I', as it is shown on map of the G. & T. C. R. R. Comp. — The N. E. line of said Sec. 190, C to D I found to be 1545 vrs., while said map calls it 1454. As the E. corner D is an old established corner, made and acknowledged by former Surveyors, and further, as Chas. Foretzschmar has placed his fences by said corner, as directed by the said former surveyors, — I did not deem it practicable and admissible to move it. The meanders of San Bernard from Gammel's

S. W. line (A) to Allen's N. E. line were also actually runned and are given in the fieldnotes of the 1<sup>st</sup> 1/4 Sec, applied for by Aug. Ewald.

To be sure of the correct location of said Allen's E. corner, I runned the S. E. line of the same from San Bernard<sup>(J)</sup> where it is marked by old marks through some scattering timber, out to the corner I, and thus found "I." to be the right and correct position for the East corner of John Allen's 320 Acs. Survey.

(J-G). The San Bernard appears to be nearly correct on the aforesaid map of the H. & T. C. R. R. comp., thereby leaving about 235 Acs. in the 4<sup>th</sup> or last quart. Sec. not applied for up to date.
