I respectfully submit the result of my survey made in order to locate Sects. 150 & 152. — I began at the E. corner of Sect. 146, a mound (-i-) in the N. W. line of the San Felipe Pawn tract, a well recognized point, examined and found to be correct by Co. Surveyor Mr. M. K. Kimmey about one year ago. — Thence I runned N. 45° W. 1901 vrs. and established common corner for Nos. 146, 145 & 149; thence: same course, at 1901 vrs. established W. corner for 145 and N. cor. 149 in S. E. line 144; thence: S. 45° W. 360 vrs. established S. cor. 144 & E. cor. 150 in N. W. line 149; thence: N. 45° W. at 1901 vrs. made common corner for Nos. 144, 150, 151 & 143; thence: S. 45° W. at 1901 vrs. established com. cor. for Nos. 150, 151, 153 & 154; thence: N. 45° W. at 1901 vrs. established W. cor. of 151 & and N. cor. of 153 in the S. E. line of 151; thence: N. 45° E. with same at 1901 vrs. the N. cor. of 151, at 2484 vrs. made E. cor. of 152 & S. cor. 142 in N. W. line of 143; thence: N. 45° W. 1227 vrs. made com. cor. for 152 & 142; thence: N. 45° W. at 2945 vrs. made W. cor. 152 & N. cor. 166; thence: N. 45° E. at 1227 vrs. made S. cor. 152 & E. cor. 166 in the

N. W. line of 153; thence: N. 45° E. 470 vrs.
 to the before made N. cor. for 151. —
 As the attached sketch shows, I found the
 N. W. line of No. 152 to be about 608 vrs.
 over in the N. W. Landrum Survey and
 some distance in the R. B. Deal, The
 S. E. line of the said Landrum divides said
 No. 152 on the ground nearly into two equal
 halves. — Please let me know as soon as
 possible, whether or not I shall regard the
 sd. Landrum line ^{and also R. B. Deal's} a governing and valid
 one, or shall I move out the N. W. line of
 Sections 152 & 142 for quantity. I wish to
 send in field notes of 152 & 150. —

I also most respectfully call your at-
 tention to my report of date Aug. 6/81
 regarding survey of Courtisio l. l. d. l. c.
 and adjoining school lands. I would
 prefer an answer of some before making
 out field notes of some adjoining surveys.
