Ludwig, County Surveyor of Austin County to locate H. & T.C. surveys lying South East of the town tract as well as connection from the S.W. corner of the town tract to the N.W. corner of the Vital Flores league, which please file in connection with the work sent you some months ago by me.

Statement of connecting lines  
 run by A. Ludwig County Surveyor  
 of Austin County to locate the N. & T. C.  
 W. By lands lying S. E. of the San Felipe  
 Town tract in Austin County.

I began my survey on the 25<sup>th</sup> of Nov  
 ember 1894 at an old Tin Oak stump  
 2 1/2 feet in diameter (formally marked  
 "C" which I have seen) on the East bank  
 of Allen's Creek and called for in the  
 Stephen Richardson field notes. There  
 is a tall Iron T rail set in the ground  
 beside the stump and an old marked  
 line runs N 54 E from it. Thence I  
 ran S 30 <sup>N 1/2</sup> E at 56 vs. Creek 96 vs. to the  
 old mouth of small prairie. Thence  
 North 80 W 160 vs. crossing said plough  
 several times. Thence N 75 W 00 vs. pt.  
 Thence N 45 E 50 vs. to the West corner  
 of S. Richardson's survey in the bed of  
 said prairie.

Thence N 45 W 1260 vs. to an iron draw  
 head in the prairie. Thence North 602  
 vs. along old fence line of Miles  
 Allen's to a rock set by Mr. Kinney  
 about 25 years ago for the South  
 corner of W. W. Allen's 1/4 league - fr. wh. a  
 Sp. O. bears S 70 1/2 W 14 vs. — Thence  
 N 45 W 471 1/2 vs. (F) N call is 4700) to a rock  
 set in O. S. Cannon's South fence line  
 for the West Cor. of said Allen Survey.

1 Thence S 45 W 397 vs. set a rock for South  
2 Corner of No 162 at South corner of O. G.  
3 Cannon's fence —

4 Thence S 45 W 1947 vs. set a rock for S.  
5 corner of No 200 at the South corner of  
6 J. S. Dabney's fence — Thence S 45 W 7947 vs.  
7 set cedar Post for South corner of Survey  
8 No 199.

9 Thence N 45 W at 1848 vs. cross Dabney's  
10 fence 46 vs. W 45 E off its South Cor. — 2024  
11 reset a cedar post for the W Cor. of No 199  
12 & South Cor. of 182. Thence N 45 W 1856 vs.  
13 to a corner of No 205 on the S. E. line of the  
14 Town Tract.

15 Thence S 45 W at 400 vs. cross East Bernard  
16 river 1147 vs. to Cedar Post set by E. F. Batts  
17 for South Cor. of the San Felipe town  
18 Tract. Thence S 45 W 6154 vs.  
19 to a cedar post 2 feet high set by Batts  
20 for the W. corner of said Town Tract —

21 Thence N 45 E along the line of said  
22 Town Tract finding it marked by  
23 cedar posts as indicated upon the  
24 sketch hereto attached, and marked "A"  
25 at 3610 vs. Crooked Branch (S) at 3818 vs.  
26 2<sup>nd</sup> mile post at 5243 vs. West bank of  
27 a dry branch at 5727 vs. 3<sup>rd</sup> mile post  
28 at 6033 vs. centre of E. Bernard, at 7633  
29 vs. 4<sup>th</sup> mile post at 9544 vs. 5<sup>th</sup> mile  
30 post, at 10975 vs. Iron Stk. and tall cedar  
31 post Kinklers West corner, at 11453 vs.  
32 6<sup>th</sup> mile post at 11754 M. N. & T. By Tract

at 13461 vs. H. C. & S. F. Vay track at 14917  
vs. a rock, the South West corner of S. F.  
Austin Lg at 19224 vs. enter timber at  
19357 vs. pass a pin oak 30" diameter  
with very old blazes and I think original  
ones, at 19498 vs. Oak 30" dia with very  
old blazes at 19877 vs. to a rock set on old  
bank of river for the North corner of the  
San Felipe town tract - The original blazes &  
rings are gone - The river at this point  
has moved Eastward leaving a new bank  
which is about 10 feet below the level of  
the old one & 27 vs further W 45 E - The line  
of the old bank is clearly defined however  
by the line of the old trees and its elevation  
above the new deposit of the river.

There is difference of 77 vs in my chaining  
and that of Surveyor Battle's on this  
line - an average of about  $7\frac{1}{2}$  vs. to the  
mile.

The Town Tract has been sold and  
sub-divided by the Battle corners and  
many improvements erected in accord-  
ance with them and I therefore accept  
his corners as the true corners of the said  
town tract -

Beginning again at the South corner  
of the Town Tract as set by Battle - I run  
S 45 E 1856 vs and set the South corner  
of No 205 - Thence S 45 E 448 vs and  
set the North corner of No 209 -

1 Thence S 45° E 1709 vrs to the East cor. of  
 2 No. 209. Thence S 45° E at 1759 vrs a point  
 3 Thence S 45° E 209 vrs and N 45° E 493 vrs  
 4 to the supposed original North corner of  
 5 the J. Laesch Survey fr. wh. a lone P. O. 24"  
 6 ran on the E. T. Bank of the Sandy  
 7 Bernard river brs. N 86° E 245 vrs.  
 8 Thence S 45° E. at 240 vrs. the bank of  
 9 Sandy San Bernard (S.) which fits  
 10 the call for said river in the field  
 11 notes of J. Laesch —

 13 Beginning again at a cedar post  
 14 set for E. corner of the Vital Flores League  
 15 Thence S 45° W at 1580 vrs to a slough  
 16 1855 vrs to present E. bank of the San Bernard  
 17 River. 5100 to cedar post set for South  
 18 corner of said league. Thence N 45° W  
 19 5100 vrs. to a cedar post on North bank  
 20 of Cochatta branch opposite the mouth  
 21 of a small branch this being the  
 22 West corner of said league. Thence down  
 23 Cochatta branch with its meanders  
 24 as follows: S 81½° E 970, North 88½° E 460,  
 25 S 55° E 270, to its junction with the San  
 26 Bernard River.

 28 I further certify that I have on previous  
 29 occasions indentified the corner of  
 30 the W. H. Strahan and Jane Boykins  
 31 Survey and have run the connections  
 32 from said surveys across Sections

1 Nos 231<sup>44</sup>, 232, and the S. B. Evans Surveys  
2 to the M. W. Allen South corner and  
3 that the distances given in the  
4 field notes of the several surveys  
5 mentioned are practically correct—  
6 Surveyed November 26<sup>th</sup> to Dec. 1<sup>st</sup> incl. 1894
