Field notes of a survey for Annie Lee Alexander of the Channel or bed of the Colorado River, extending downstream from the lower corner of the Bastrop Town Tract (near the mouth of Gills Branch) to the center-line of the M.K. & T. Rail Road bridge near the Lightfoot- Knight & White original survey corner.

Beginning at the N.E. margin of said river channel on an extension of the Town Tract- S.F. 


