myself in this County in Bk. This
Connectivity line was run at the suggestion
of Mr Baker, specially to determine
the width N. & S. of the N. Tier of sections
and to find where the Half Mile was
lost on the E line. It was lost between
N.E. Cor 15 & S.E. Cor 15. And as 16 precedes
17 we (Bedford & I) believe it was lost or at
least 17 should lose. It. We want your
opinion about the width of the three tiers
of sections north & west from the N.E. Cor

Compare position of line No 87, etc. 55, 57 & 90.
two cross lines with river cuts at 57 & 58.
Also by Connectivity line you will see

that the N. line 118 has been definitely located
by Natural objects. To Get your judge-
ment on this part of our connection I hand
you herewith Corrected field notes to Sect 118,
which please pass upon as soon as possible.

I wish to say that all the Surveys
previous to Mr W. A. Jones Recognized
the Gulch at the end of Dist 9500 as West
of ^{NE cor} No 10 as being the one described in
field notes. If there is any kind of a Gulch
at the proper Course & Dist from E line
Why go farther west for another and thus
destroy the Natural Colls at the next
two corners farther west as well as
to nullify all the work previously done
Well I have worried long over
this and await your Verdict
with Interest hoping you will be
just to property in this 200th run
I strip to the amount of many thousand Dollars.
