We would now like to call your attention
to how we crossing branches running
west from a pt 5 vrs east of gulch
named above. This point being found
by Mr Kerr to be 9500 vrs West

of the D.C. Com Survey No 10 this blk.
assuming this to be ^{by the field notes} the S.W. Cor of 83.

Thence West at 1900 vrs a pt on E side
of ^{low} gravelly ridge covered with mesq grass.
for N.E. Cor sur no 118.

Thence West at 175 vrs cross br, with
with spring in head at 200 vrs small
dair at 225 vrs another drain at 750 vrs
pass bend of br on the S. at 930 vrs

cross same br at 1350 no cross charge
br at 1550 no east bank of Small
br at 1875 no large elm br at 1902
no a ^{dead} mes stump 10 in high and 10 in
dia. a number of trees mkd with one
hack each which looked to be pretty old,
are found both N + S of this pt and
11 elm with 1 stunting hack just
north of our line running east.
One of them was 40 or 50 no out of line.
He There are no branches on the S. line
of 118 as called for in the field notes
and further on there is no gulch
at S.W. Cor of Sect 82 and these
branches are west of a gulch at
N.W. cor 82, 2
