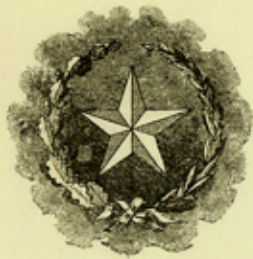

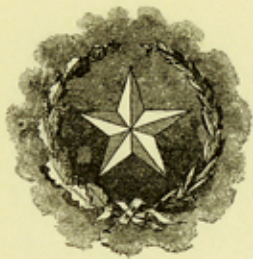

Dear Sir

I am inclosing to you under separate cover a map of the north part of Blks A, B, C, in Baylor and Knox Counties. I must however apologize for the appearance of the map, but I had no better material with which to make but hope it will serve the purposes for which it is intended. It shows first of all some new developments as to east line of Block A to wit- that Mr Hill measured from SE corner of Block north (without any variation turned off) to about SE corner No 12 and that he measured from NE corner of Block south to what we now call Gray Creek. It also shows that calls for branches and other natural objects (except the river calls) are found on north line 82, 118 et instead of one mile farther south, in fact even the river call of S & 171 is found at its NE corner.

There is a stone mound in a gulch 9507 vs 7812 of NE corner of No 10 and from it a small meay bone

535° W (Magnetic) about 20 rods marked x on
S. side the other x rotted out, also a Hackberry
on S.W. point of Hill bears proper course for the
two trees called for.

measuring west from the corner 1900 rods in valley
of Spring branch continuing west cross a noted
Spring branch at 170 rods at 400 rods cross head
of branch at 1345 rods a spring branch at 1900 rods
to the stump of mesquite tree about 10 in dia

On this same line the S.E. corner of 170 is about
as called for in section 176

In making out field notes of sect 192 I
recognize of course the ^{original} N.E. corners of sections
+ 84 and 86 of this block, and same time
recognize the original corner at N.E. corner
of section 99 + common corner of 82, 83, 98 + 99
and I also recognize the N.W. corner of 99 as
given by natural objects on N. line 118
To do so lines of surveys intervening between
these lines necessarily run N6°E instead of
