Young Co. School Land, the J. K. Crow and S 1/2 Sec. No. 2
H & T C R R Co. for W. P. Waggoner,

First Beginning at the N.E. Corner of Survey No 5
I & M C R R Co. Cent No and SW Cor of Survey No 247,

Same Sec, 2d S E Cor 1/2 Sec No 1 H & T C R R Co.

Thence North 1435 rs to stone mark the S E Cor of
Survey No 2 + N E Cor No 1 H & T C R R Co

Thence West 200 9° 30' at 1204 1/2 rs a stone

and the original N.W. Corner of said No 1 and
SW Corner No 2.

Thence S 30 E at 1270 rs pass 1 or to right

of the J. K. Crow S.E. Corner located 41° W

from the mouth of Antelope Creek or Miller Creek,

Note Mr D. H. Jones of this Co. in 1882. The Hallings

worth of Young Co and myself all came

out within a radius of 50 rs from this stone

marked. The Course of river down stream

is S 78 1/2 E and general Course up stream S 30° W.

From this mark I ran S 60 W 672 rs + S 30 E 300 rs

for S.W. Cor J. K. Crow and S.E. Cor of M. Bradley,

Thence S 60° W 672 rs + S 30 E 504 rs to SW Cor said M.

Bradley. The two surveys named as well as

the J. K. McNeil fit the river very correctly.

The S E Cor of the Bradley Survey in edge of what
appears and old bed of river and about 75 rs N of
present bank and American River & Huckberry lines.

The ~~SE~~ corner of the M. Bradley I ran $N 20 E 39^{\circ}$
to a bunch of elm Hackberry and $N 63 W 21/2$ to
a Hackberry not marked, that I could tell. These are
the calls in the field notes of the M. Bradley.

from the SE corner of Crow I continued $S 29^{\circ} 39' E$
at 1135 (from Crow.) to a stone md at my eyes thence
this stone md was claimed by Young Lee for S.E. Cor. of
her school Land. Thence $S 46 W 1250$ to the
East line of Young Lee. School Land.
Thence

2nd Connection. Beginning at the West ~~of~~ ^{or} Chertim Corner
of Young Lee. School Land

Thence $N 60 E$ at 3874 to pass 11 to $S 90 W$ of a
stone md the SE Cor of Survey No 55 B.L.K.A. 2747 to
 $S 90 W$ of its N.W. Corner, at 6626 to cross N. line of
Survey No 19 B.L.K.A. at 6990 to a stone md
the North Corner of Young Lee. School Land on upland
prairie as described in its original Field Notes. Said
original corner being called for eightly varas further
 $N 60 E$, which would still be on this upland prairie.

(returning to point on N. line of No 19.) Lost Corner.
Thence $N 9^{\circ} E 1020$ to N.W. Cor said No 19 its elm
bearing tree was still standing.

Thence $S 81 E$ at 1958 to pass N.E. Cor No 19. at 3912 to
to N.E. corner.

Thence $S 9^{\circ} W 1900$ to S.E. Cor 18 at 2906 to pass Copper
Hill (see map 8. N. 17) at 3206 pass about 20 to N of
stone md the only SW Cor No 2. but in running

N 90° E from the round road called for in survey no 14
this show road is on H.S. line no 17 and Conflicts 1 or 2 rods
with J. H. Crow.
