First Beginning at the N.E. corner of Survey No 5
H&T C RR Co. Cor. No. and SW cor. of Survey No 247,
Same loc., 3d S 8 Cor $\frac{1}{2}$ sec 2. 1 H&T C RR Co.

Thence North 1435 rs to stns and the SE cor of
Survey No 2 + NE cor No 1 H&T C RR Co.
Thence West 200 $9^{\circ} 30'$ at 1204 $\frac{1}{2}$ rs to stns
and the original N.W. corner of said No 1 and
SW corner No 2.

Thence S 30 E at 1270 rs pms, or to right
of the J. K. Crowe S.E. corner located $21^{\circ} W$
from the mouth of Antelope Creek or Miller Creek,
Note Mr D. H. Jones, of this Co. in 1882. Mr Hollings
worth of Young Co and myself all came
out within a radius of 50 ms from this stns
located. The course of river down stream
is S $78\frac{1}{2}$ E and general course up stream S 30° W,
From this rd I ran S 60 W 672 rs + S 30 E 300 ms
for S.H. Lee J.K. Crowe and S.E. Cor of M. Bradley.

Thence S 60° W 672 rs + S 30 E 504 ms to SW cor said M.
Bradley. The two surveys named as well as
the J. H. McNeil fit the river very correctly.
The S E Cor of the Bradley being in edge of what
appears and old bed of river and about 75 rs N of
present bank and among shrub & buckberry trees.

The S E corner of the Mr; Bradley I ran N 20 E 39° to a bunch of elm & huckleberry and N 63 W 212 rs to a huckleberry not marked, that I could tell. There are the calls in the field notes of the Mr Bradley, from the S E corner of envr I continued S 29 E 39° E at 1135 (from Cmtr.) to a stone rd, at one end of which this elm rd was claimed by Young less for S. E. cor. of her school Land. Thence S 46 W 1250 rs to the East line of Young less. School Land.
There.

2nd Connection. Beginning at the West ^{or} Chettim corner of Young less. School Land
Thence N 60 E at 3874 rs pass 11 rs S 90 W of a stone rd the S E cor of Survey No 55 Blk A 2747 rs S 90 W of its N. W corner, at 6626 rs across W. line of Survey No 19 Blk A at 6990 rs a stone rd the North corner of Young less. School Land on upland prairie as described in the original Field Notes. Said original corner being called for eighty rods further N 60 E, which would still be on this upland prairie.

{ returning to point on W. line of No 19, 7 lost corner.
Thence N 90 E 1020 rs to N W cor said No 19 its elm bearing tree was still standing.
Thence S 81 E at 1958 rs pass N E cor No 19. at 2912 rs to N. E. corner.

Thence S 90 W 1960 rs to S E cor 18 at 2906 rs pass Copper Hill (see my 8. 4. 17) at 3206 pass about 20 rs N of stone rd the only S W cor No 2. but in running

N 9° E from the round rd called for in survey No 14
this line and is on H.S. line No 17 and Conf lds 1 or 2 mns
with J. K. Crow.
