Dear Sirs

Enclosed please find a new corrected set of Field notes, I have made an entirely new survey of all the lands represented on the sketch. I have found beyond doubt the S.W. cor of the Upshur & County School Land and the N.W. cor. of the T & N. O. R. R. Co survey No 1.

You will please explain to the Court, that the Red dotted line represents the position the Ward & Roome and the DeBow an Kerns surveys would occupy if surveyed from the S.E. cor of the D. N. Paige survey across the River (see its Field notes). I do not think they can hold that position. Also please notify him (as does the connecting line enclosed) that I found two of the corners of the A. B & M. over on the T & N. O. sur. No 1. If he does not accept the position I give No 1 A. B & M. let me know soon and I will try to get Hughes & Simpson to have patent cancelled and new survey made ~~low may~~. This sworn statement I think will settle or ought to settle the question as to where Mr Hawes Cor. He took me to his S.W. cor and showed me the spot which he identified by two dead trees and said "when you and Jones were working around here last winter trying to move the Ward"

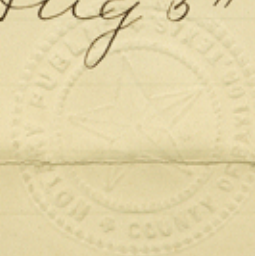
I, A. D. Kerr County

Survey to be on the ground 1298 varas  
East of said Ward Survey and the N. W.  
Cor of said Howe Survey to be 1298 varas  
East and 206 varas North of I. S. Ward's

Exhibit A, <sup>and hereto attached</sup> is a true and correct  
representation of all the surveys  
platted thereon as found by me by  
actual survey upon the ground
