Enclosed

find two applications made by
Mr A. A. Sterling for a survey
of certain lands in Baylor
County, one of which tracts is
shown upon the map of Baylor
Co., as lying south of the J. W. Kerns
and other surveys, and north of
the A B & M surveys nos 1 & 2.
The other vacancy was supposed
by Mr Sterling to lie between
the J & M & R Co surveys nos
1, 2, 3 & 4 and the Upshur Co.
School Lands. I also inclose
connecting lines showing condition
of these lands. There ought not to be
any doubt hereafter as to the true
location of these surveys. Owing to
irregular measurement some of
these lines appear to be at about 9° var
and others at $9^{\circ} 30'$; but I think his
true variation is $9^{\circ} 30'$ and by
misplacement some of them are at
var of 9° or little less.
For the purposes of this survey it was
unnecessary to establish the N.E. Cor

of the Travis County School Land
but running east from the N.W.
Cor of the Travis at 90 and then
north at 90 we would cross Wagon
Creek at about 3243 ns north of the
N.E. Cor of Travis County School Land
which would be about as called for
in Field notes of N. Co. Sch. Ld.
But the bearings do not bear such
a variation all around. I have a
letter from Gen Hudson, who did
the work and is still alive at Gainesville
in which letter he ~~indecipherably~~ ^{intimates} that I
would likely find it somewhat irreg-
ular.

These facts are certainly I have found
N.W. Cor Travis Co Sch. Ld. S.E. Cor Colorado
Co Sch. Ld. N.W. Cor Calvin Farmer
S.W. Cor H. St. Haggard and N.W. Cor
J. J. Good, also the crossings on branches
on East line, Colorado going South
and from N.E. Cor upshur in Baylor
going South to Wagon Creek.

I hope you will be able to ~~search~~ ^{revise}
the map of Baylor Co in accordance
with these field notes
