Field notes of a survey  
of a connecting line made for  
D. A. Sterling by virtue of his application  
for a portion of the unsurveyed Public  
School Land made June 14<sup>th</sup> 1900.  
Beginning at a stone <sup>N.W. Cor. Prairie Co. S. 1d</sup> md <sub>11</sub> 312  
000 north and about 21.292 vs west  
of the N.E. Cor of Survey No 2131  
T. E. L. Co. in Throckmorton Co. from which  
stone md <sup>bush on a</sup> <sub>1</sub> round md <sub>1</sub> <sup>to</sup> S 18 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 229  
thence N 71 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 100 vs and same bush <sup>from corner</sup> <sub>1</sub> <sup>round</sup>  
S 16 $^{\circ}$  10' E (about 2290 vs <sub>1</sub> to foot of <sub>1</sub> md  
(This md is what is called in this country  
a mountain, but viewing it from  
the corner we only see about 10 feet of  
the top and appears to be only a md.)  
From this <sup>stone</sup> <sub>1</sub> md a mes tree <sub>1</sub> to N 64 W 35 vs  
(growing from a large mes tree  $\bar{x}$  (20 year  
mark) <sub>1</sub> to S 75 $^{\circ}$  W 85 vs.  
and a round md 200 vs <sup>N</sup> south of the  
mouth of Rocky Canyon <sub>1</sub> to N 9 $^{\circ}$  45' W  
and from a point N 80 W same md <sub>1</sub> to  
N 9 $^{\circ}$  W.  
thence S (var 9 $^{\circ}$  30') <sub>1</sub> at 1030 vs cross Co. line  
at 5000 vs a point  
among rocks on east end of ridge  
from this point a dead mes tree  
marked <sub>1</sub> to S 37 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 20 vs, and  
an other mes tree <sub>1</sub> to N 19 $^{\circ}$  W 4 vs  
but find no sign of mark in it  
This marked tree places the corner

about 20 vs East of the md called  
for in my connecting line made  
in 1887. I have no doubt about  
the N.E. Cor of Upper County  
School Land being <sup>originally</sup> placed at  
this point. I ran to this pt in 1887  
2<sup>nd</sup> but <sup>did not discover the marked mes.</sup> began my at the stone md  
for N.W. Cor of Travis Co. School  
Land whence a round md brs  
S  $18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E 2290 vs (to foot of md)  
thence North at 3850 cross junction  
enter prong of Rocky Canyon  
at 4220 vs cross branch  
at 4254 vs cross South line of J.K.  
Kerns Survey, 2853 vs east  
of its S.W. Corner (measured) at 5000  
vs draw a stake, whence a dead mes  
stump brs N  $49^{\circ}$  W 9 vs. and a stone  
set for N.E. Cor of Colorado County  
School Land brs N  $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E 71 vs, said  
stone being located at that point by  
Mr Jackson surveyor for Colorado  
County.

thence East 4545 vs a stake.  
thence north 1150 vs to a pile of stone  
whence a large P.O. in valley mtd Z  
brs N  $49\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  E 604 vs. the original bearing  
tree of Survey No 1 cert no  $\frac{30}{409}$  made  
for L.O.N.O.R.R.C.
