J. A. Sterling by virtue of his
application for a portion of the unsurveyed
Public School Land, made June
14th 1900.

J. E. & L. Co. Beginning at the stone mark
for the N.E. corner of the survey No 2131
whence a large mes. tree still standing
bys S $27\frac{3}{4}$ W 10 vs, said corner being
490 vs west of the S.E. corner of the
Polk Co. Sch. L^d Thence West
on N. line of the J. E. & L. Co's survey
Nos 2131, 2152 etc. at 10.592 vs
to the S.W. cor of the Griffith Preemption
thence north 1283 vs a point at foot
of rocky bluff. Thence E 700 vs
and found no st. mark in that
vicinity.

Thence Continuing north from the
N.W. cor of the Griffith Preemption
at 1350 vs a point on hill.

17 Course North (var N 10° E).

18 Thence North (var 10° E) with fence
19 line at 804 vs pass 155 vs
20 East of a stone md near where
21 I thought placed the S.W. Cor. of
22 the J. J. Good Survey by
23 field notes of Survey No
24 D, L, & C, Co, but find no stone
25 md west, ^{at 669 vs} but in rocky ground,
