1st Field Notes of Connections made in Baylor County to Locals S. B. Line of the Edward Brown Survey, Beginning at a stone mark the original S. W. Cor of Survey No 16 for Thomson & Baker, whence a hickory tree N 54 E 50 vs marked X Thence N 68 W 745 vs., a stake could make no bearings fit (This point is 300 vs north of the Bank of the River and calls to be on the River.

Thence N 100 vs, Thence N 1083 vs to a point in sand hill no mesq here.

Th S 100 vs, in valley some evidence of mesq growth, Thence but we were 150 vs N of River as it now is and 200 vs North of where it was 10 years ago.

2nd Beginning at a stone mark on Turkey Creek for the N. W. Cor of the Wm Garbrough Survey. This is the recognized Cor. an elm with X at 12 in from ground br S 92 W to about 70 vs and an elm br S 71 W about 72 vs, no marks visible.

Whence South at 91 vs a br, at 181 vs cross Turkey Creek

From stone mark Thence (over 100) East at 950 vs stake 13 vs west of wire gate. Thence South at 1390 vs

a pt in N Edge of P.O. Shinery,
 Thence (by offset) East 560 vs
 Thence S. at 506 vs cross
 N. line of Edward Brown as
 previously surveyed, at 1744
 vs to the S. line of Edw. Brown survey,
 Thence West at 120 vs cross
 Turkey Creek at 560 vs
 back on our line, Thence
 S 530 vs set a stone about
 5 vs North of bluff of River
 practically on bank of Brazos
 River, for SE Cor the H. M. Garbrough,
 3rd Thence N 530, Thence
 East at 440 vs cross creek
 at 494 vs pt 20 vs North
 of bank of creek, at ~~1294~~¹³⁰⁵ vs
 a pt 100 vs from high steep
 bluff of River, whence a Cottonwood
 on bank of river in low valley
 below to S 83 E 60 vs MKd X
 The Cotton wood is growing in
 soil only 3 or 4 feet deep. The
 original bearing true.

Thence North at 170 vs pt. a
 line running east would run
 into the River at 800 vs, so we
 continued North to 270 vs, in field
 Thence East at 800 vs a pt 100
 vs North of bank of River
 The river fell in 40 vs in
 1 day during 1897, at 900 vs
 fd no sign of hrs at 1400 vs
 we are South of the West end
 of first run, no bearings
 we are 20 vs North of bank of River

at 2486 on a stake 140 vs S of the
S W Cor Sur No 16 Thomson & Baker
~~at 2486 vs a stake~~ ²²160 vs

North of Bank of River.
I think the S W Cor Survey No 16
Thomson & Baker was 100 vs
south of this pt on bank of
River (or marsh).

I did not find the points as
well marked as desired but
think this is the proper position
for this survey. It is excessive
