Relating to surveys in Baylen County I would state that the corners established by me and to which the protest relates are as and for the information of this company and although I refer to in my report to the fact that my measurements do not agree with those claiming to be the original corners (which I do not believe to be the fact) and which measurements have in part been confirmed by surveys of the Deputy Surveyor, yet that referee does not in any manner effect the work done by me under your authority, the notes and corners to which you often run added to my

report for the information of your office and not as a part of my official duties, as you will observe I changed no original forms nor in fact any drawn, as those to which the protest refers were not found, although a thorough search was made for them by my entire party and far beyond the limit designated in the protest, I claim my work to be correct and protest any change thereof unless I am present to see the work done, with an experience of thirty years as a Civil Engineer I believe myself as competent as any man in Texas and much more so than any Falak that can be produced in that country.

Whereas a survey was made by H.R. Scott
to determine conflicts in Baylin County
the report whereof was filed in the Land
Land office, said report bearing date of
March 16th 1879, and whereas a protest
has been filed in relation thereto by one
Wm. F. Rosenberg in behalf of the settlers
in said County, not one of which settlers has
by this survey been deprived of any property
real or personal and none of which own
a foot of land within the limits affected
by said survey, and believing the said
survey to be correct, therefore unless the
same be accepted as correct by the Bureau of
the Land Office in so far as said report
relates, to corrections and relations of
initial corners as set forth therein, In
the name of the Texas and New Orleans
Railroad Company I hereby protest against
the recovery of said lands except all parties
interested shall receive ninety days notice
of said survey and the time at which it
will be made and I further protest that
none other than a known expert as a
surveyor, and a nonresident of that
section of the country be appointed
