with the chainmen qualified
and that said surveys were
made to properly locate the Tishomingo
County School Land and 1, 2, 3, 4, 69
and 70 Texas ^{2d} N O R R Co,
and also to locate ^{to 4 miles} the position of the
D. S. Ward John Rome and John
Horve surveys by bearing trees and
river caes from the S. E. cor. D. H. Price Survey ^{11/16}
Beginning at a pt ^{30 ft} \$49^{3/4} W 60⁴ m.
First ^{marked}
of a large P. C. in valley of Brazos
River. the NW Con Survey ^{70/1 cert 30/40}
N & N O R R Co.

Hence S 69⁰⁰ vrs. Hence W 45⁰⁰
vrs. Thence S 8³ vrs and all fall
of stone. Whence East end of the
West one of Town Mountains
by S 18^{1/2} E about 1 mile
Hence E at 1000 vrs ~~fall~~ pass stone
mkd X^{IV}; passing T, T, T, T, mile
stones on the Throckmorton and ^{XIII, XII, XI, X} Baylor
County lines. at 10,000 vrs made a

pile of stone for S E corner of Twpshn
County School Land.

Hence North at 1443 we pass a pt
stones scattered 30 ft around
probably cor of Calvin Farmer-
Survey, at 3643 we cross Wagon
Creek at 5700. one stone whence a
dead tree stump bns N 8° W 71 0rs and
