Dear Sir I have made some resurveys of Nos 10, 11, 12 & 13 & 14 of Bee County School Lands

I began at the S.W. corner of the Geo O'Doherty Survey, an established corner by a decree of the District Court, Thence N 27 W at 1150 is a north cor of Pat O'Byles survey and the N.E. cor of M. Lawler.

Thence with the Lawler & Lutes Surveys & No 14 for Bee County 5173 is the N.W. cor of No 14 and the S.W. cor of Geo O'Doherty as claimed by the owners of the same though nothing to identify said cor,

Thence N 63 E 8043 is to the Paqueta creek, I then measured back on said line 6087 is to the S.W. corner of John Ryan.

Thence N 27 W 3307 is for the N.W. cor of John Ryan. Thence N 63 E 7742 is to Paqueta creek.

I then began at the N.E. cor of Simon Dwyer, & the N.W. cor of Antonio Carrier on the bank of the creek.

Thence S 63 W 3000 is for the ^{N.W.} ~~S.W.~~ cor

of Antonio Currier, (the field notes
of A. Currier calls for 2925 vs on this line
though I suppose I began nearer to
the creek than they) Thence S 16° E
3310 vs for the S. W. cor of said Survey
Thence N 63 E 6380 vs to the Paiute
creek. Thence with the meanders of
the creek downward, as follows,

S 62 E 290

S 83 1/2 E 1030

N 63 E 58

S 89 1/2 E 1000

S 80 E 420

S 27 E 500

N 69 E 280

N 82 E 400 to the upper corner

of John Ryan's Survey.

There is not a single corner of
these surveys, (I mean A Currier &
John Ryan) that can be identified
on the ground. The meanders
called for in A Currier's field notes
do not fit the creek by a great
deal. Consequently I do not think
he can hold to John Ryan's boundary.

If you are satisfied with these
statements under my oath of office
and will permit the same, I will
forward the field notes of surveys 11, 12, 10
