That the field notes of a survey
of 404 $\frac{1}{10}$ acres of land, being a
Correction of a 640 acre sur.
for the State of Texas by virtue
of Cert. No 3/570 issued by the
Comm. Genl. Land on the 30th day
of Dec. 1872 to the H & G. N. R. R. Co.
and situated in Bee Co. on the
East bank of Paesta Creek and
about 5 miles S.E. of Burville, are
correct. and that the S. W. Cor.
of the Edward Ryan Grant is
Correctly located by my beginning
at the junction of the Aransas
and Paesta Creeks and meander-
ing the first named Creek upward
to the N. W. Cor. of the T. J. Malloy
Grant Thence following the North
line of said Malloy Grant to
the Paesta Creek = Thence up
the Paesta Creek with its meanders
to the N. E. Cor. of Geo. O'Leachanly
Grant. + S. E. Cor. of John Ryan
Grant. which is the initial cor.
of Edward Ryan Grant.

By beginning at the S. W. Cor. of
John Ryan Sur. as established by
J. M. Sunlap and running N 53 E.

0. 30' West of Magnetic I intersect the
 S. E. Cor. of John Ryan sur. Made by me:
 auditing the Paista - This sur for
 the State was never made on the
 ground, but from Skunkap's Call-
 ings in his field notes for David
 A. Kerr. - I found the North and
 South lines of the D. A. Kerr sur.
 but the bearing tree has disappeared.
 I have correctly located the
 the West line of Phebe Crane
 Sur. being governed by J. M. Skun-
 kap's Field notes, a copy of which
 are enclosed. As the ground is
 quite sandy the creek has changed
 its channel at least 100 yards
 since J. M. Skunkap located the
 D. A. Kerr sur. I have run all
 around the State sur. twice and
 it is correctly defined in my field
 notes now on file in your
 office.
