Sir,

Your letter of 17th is received - In regard to the Berryman survey - The call S. 19° W. 1640 7²° is correct, by actual measurement -

I think a report of Saul McMillin's survey of the Mc Moreno Grant was forwarded to the G. L. O. But in any case I shall delay sending you a transcript of the Decree of Court until further orders from you, for the reason that in the suit of "D. Ayes et al. vs Phillips & Worrall," our District Ct. rendered a judgment locating the North boundary of the Moreno Grant nearly coincident with the North line of the W. W. Daws' 1/3 League, which is correct running 87° E. from the N. W. corner as located by measurement from the junction of Leon & Lampasas rivers - This suit is now in Supreme Court, on appeal from our Dist. Court. The judgment above mentioned orders the Berryman patent to be cancelled. I thought perhaps it was best to await the decision of the Supreme Ct. & if the judgment is affirmed to furnish your office with the decree & corrected

map in accordance therewith - If you desire it
