Field Notes of a Survey of 14 Suertes
of irrigable land, situated in the Labor
of the old Mission of San Juan Capis-
trano, about 8 miles below the City of San
Antonio de Bexar - made for J. Guilbeau

(C) Beginning at a stake set on the bank of the
Main or outside ditch of the Labor of San-
Juan, for the lower corner on said ditch of
Two Suertes granted originally to José Gra-
mado, and now owned by the heirs of J. G.

Elder died - from which stake, which is just
above a road and a gully, crossing the ditch,
a Mesquite 4 in. dia, bears S. $14\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W. $9\frac{1}{4}$ varas, &
a Hackberry 3 in dia, bears N. 13° E. $5\frac{1}{4}$ varas, the
Steeple of the Mission Chapel bears about S. $84\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W.

Thence S. $52\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. (78 varas to an Acquia), 170 varas

Thence S. $49\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. - 457 varas to a stake of
stone mound, in the forks of the Middle ditch
and of another ditch branching off to the right

(B) thereof - the S. E. corner of the Mission Wall
of enclosure, bears N. $5\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 274 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas -

Thence S. $53\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 337 varas to a stake of
stone mound, on the bank of the San Ant^o.

River, from which a Pecan 30 in. diam, bears
S. 49° E. $3\frac{1}{4}$ vara - The desague running along

the South side of the Mission, empties into
the river, about 353 varas N. $13\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. from this

(A) corner - which is marked A. on the plat -

Thence down the river, on a mean course of
S. $40\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. - 1480 varas, to a stake on the

upper bank of the San Antonio River, about
100 varas from the water, the upper corner.

12 varas, another 12 varas, bears N. $68\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W

Thence N. $43\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 914 varas to a stake of
(E) stone mound, on the San Juan Ditch
Thence up said ditch with its meanders, to
the place of beginning — marked (C) on plat.

(G) Beginning at a stake on the bank of the
San Juan Outer ditch, set for the lower
corner on said ditch, of the tract of $1\frac{1}{2}$ suertes
of Canuto Diaz — and which is S. $46\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 150 varas
and N. $43\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas, from the upper
corner of the same on said ditch — A Mesquite
7 varas, bears N. 76° W. 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ varas — (G) on plat.

Thence with the S. E. boundary of Canuto
Diaz — S. $43\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W. 815 varas to a stake on
(F) the bank of the river, at a bluff, from which
a Pecan 10 varas — bears N. $56\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ varas —
Thence down the river, on a mean course of
S. 26° W. 665 varas (about) to the mouth of
the Arroyo de las Coloradas — Thence, continu-
ing down the river, on a mean course of —
S. $29\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 629 varas, to a stake and stone
mound, on the bank of the river, 30 varas from
(H) the water's edge, from which a Hackberry 12
varas, bears N. $35\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. — 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ varas, a Mesquite
5 varas, bears S. 48° E. 7 varas — — marked
R' H, on plat —

Thence with the line of an old fence, said to
have been made by Padre Maynez - N. $60\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E
236 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas, to a stake in San Juan ditch
(I) marked I, on plat, from which a Hackberry
12 in dia, bears N. $35\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E - 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ varas, a Mesquite
5 in dia, bears S. 48° E - 7 varas. -

Thence up the ditch, with its meanders
to the place of beginning -
