Statement
of Survey N^o 356 Sect. 3. Bexar Co.
Presumption of W^m Finke.

I have ascertained on the ground by actual measurements that the survey N^o 356 is correctly represented as described in the original fieldnotes made out by F. R. Potshinsky, the beginning point (a stone mound on the N.W. boundary-line of Survey N^o 355, from which a Liveoak 10 in d. brs S. 80° E. 6 vs.) is 240 varas S. 41½° W. from the N. corner of survey N^o 355. N. Sanchez (a stone mid from which a Blackjack 12 in S 42 W 9 vs, another S. 7° E 9 vs.) — The last course in the Fieldnotes of survey N^o 356 calling for 560 vs N. 41½° E. to the place of beginning, was found by me corresponding on the ground by actual measurement.

The ^{South} corner, of N^o 356, a stone mid from which a mesquite 5 in brs N 67° E 28 vs, made on the N.E. boundary of survey N^o 357 A. Wetherby is N. 48½° W. 1078 vs. from the South corner of survey N^o 355. N. Sanchez, exactly on the point, where the N.W. & S.W. line of N^o 355 intersect, with each other and the corresponding boundaries of said survey, calling for 950 vs square, have 1078 to 800 vs.

The South & E. corners of the two surveys N^o 355 & 354 (J. Groll's Presumption) are set on and in the course of the N.W. boundary line of N^o 11. L. Kneipp, and the same error of 1078 vs, in stead of 950, for the S.W. & N.E. boundary of survey N^o 354, is existing.
