Report of a resurvey of the Jasper Wooldridge Survey 600 in Bexar County, Texas.

My survey began at the South corner of the J.R. Roberts Sur. 22½, a st. md. from which a 20" L.O. bears S 65° E-13 vs. and a 14" L.O. bears South 886 vs. This is a corner of Surveys 22½ and 410 and 600.

Running South 339.8 vs. to the S.W. corner of Sur. 410 a re-entrant corner of Sur. 600. Continuing South 99.7 vs. found a st. md. from which a 14" L.O. brs. N 4° W-19 vs, and an 18" L.O. brs. N 48° 30' W-30 vs. This corner was when patent was corrected to Wooldridge Feb. 10, 1913.

Returning to the S.W. corner of Sur. 410 I ran East 1102.5 vs. and found a st. md. the most Westerly corner of Sur. 599, a companion corner of Sur. 600.

Going south from this corner found a st. md. at 470.52 vs. the S.W. corner of Sur. 599 the S.E. corner of Sur. 600 in the north line of Sur. 437.

Running East at 189 vs. passed a st. md. which was set as the S.E. corner of Sur. 600 corrected to Wooldridge, at 535.18 vs found a st. md. in the East line of Sur. 433½, the N.W. corner of Sur. 437 and a S.W. corner of Sur. 600.

Then ran north with the East line of Sur. 433½ at 166.9 vs. found a st. md. for it's N.E. corner, a re-entrant corner of Sur. 600.

Running west along the North line of Sur. 433½ at 746 vs. found a st. md. the N.W. corner of 433½ a corner of Sur. 600.

Then south with the West line of Sur. 433½, at 731.7 vs. found st. md. from which an 8" L.O. brs. N 78° E-21 vs. the N.E. corner of Sur. 435, the S.E. corner of Sur. 600.

Then on a bearing of S 89° 15' W-627.1 vs. to an intersection with the East line of the H. Leifeste Sur. 1. Found no st. md. here. A south east corner of the H. Leifeste bears South 47.5 vs f from this intersection.

Then running north from this intersection found a st. md. in a L.O. thicket on the side of a mountain at 855.1 vs. the N.E. corner of Sur. 1, a re-entrant corner of Sur. 600.

Thence West with the North line of Sur. 1 at 814 vs. found a st. md. from which a 30" L.O. brs. N 78° 40' E-51 vs. the N.W. corner of Sur. 1, a S.W. corner of Sur. 600.

Ran north to an intersection with the S.W. line of Sur. 24½ Jacob Metzler found no st. md. at this point.

Then ran S 45° E with the S.W. lines of Sorveys 24½ and 25 at 910 varas found a st. md at fence corner the South corner of Sur. 25 a corner of Sur. 600.

Report of a resurvey of the Chas.H.Seidenschnur Sur. 600 in Bexar County, Texas.

I began my survey at a st.md.in the South line of the Jas.H.Cox Sur.22, said md.being the N.W.corern of the Henry Wagenfuhr Sur.429.This corner is witnessed by a 20"L.O. brs. S 9°15'E-31vs.This is an old witness though the bearing and distance doesnot agree with the original.The tie inthe Wag- enfuhr notes to the Fredericksburg Road from this corner ag- rees fairly well with the distance as measured on the ground. This corner is recognised by Mr.Chas.H.Seidenschnur (now Chas H.Siden) as an original corner of 410.

Running South from this coraer with the common line of 410 and 429 found traces of old cutting and at 1001.63 vs. found a st.md. at a fence corner.This mound is known to Mr. Seidenschnur as the S.W.corner of Sur 429,The West part of said Sur.he hasowned for over fourty years.The tie given here to the Fredericksburg Road agrees fairly well.This corner is also the N.W.corner of Sur.599.Continuing south with the com- mon lie of Surveys 410 and 599 found a st.md.at 1198.73 vs. This corner known to Mr. Seidenschnur as the S.E.corner of Sur.410,a re-entrant corner of No.599.

Running West from this corner and with the common line of Surveys 410 and 599 found a stone md.at a fence corner the most westerly ^{now} corner of Survey 599.Continuing west the called distance for the South line of 410 searched for st.md.none found. I then went to the South corner of the J.R.Roberts Sur.22½, a st.md. at a fence corner witnessed by a 20"L.O.brns. S 65°E-13vs.and a 14"L.O. brs South-88.6vs.From here ran due south to an intersection with the South line of 410 produced West and established the S.W.corner at this point.

Returning to the South corner of Sur.22½ and running N.E.and N.W. found the East and North corners of Sur.22½, said corners being common to Sur.410.

From the North corner of Sur.22½ in the S.E.line of Sur.25 ran N 44°15'W,with the S.E.line of Sur.25,at 122.8 vs. found st.md.onlline,at 547.9 vs.found st.md.the East corner of Sur.25 a corner of Sur.410.

Running N 45°45'W from this corner found a st.md.at 513 vs.in the N.E.line of Sur.25,the N.W.corner of 410,a cor- ner of 2/409.Continuing on the same course at 121.6 vs. found a st.md.the North corner of Sur.25.

Returning to the N.W.corner of Sur.429 in the South line of Sur.22,and running West with the common line of Surveys 22 and 410,at 946.69 vs.found st.md.at fence corner the S.W.corner of Sur 22 and a corner of 410.

Running from said md. in a northerly direction with the common line of 410 and 22 at 349.9 vs.found a st.md.the N.E. corner of 410 and the S.E.corner of 2/409.

A connection was made from this point to the st.md. found in the N.E.line of Sur.25 to make theNorth line of survey 410,

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Then ran N 45°E, with the S.E. line of Sur. 25 at 200 vs. found the West corner of Sur. 22½, from which a 24" L.O. stump bears N16½E-81 vs.

Then S 45°E, with the S.W. line of Sur. 22½ to the place of beginning.

Since the original notes of this Survey call for Surveys 410 and 599, and since Surveys 599 and 600 are companion Surveys the corners established in the corrected notes of 600 patented to Wooldridge to the south and west of Surveys 599 and 410 were ignored and notes written to make the lines adjacent to Surveys 410 and 600 common to those Surveys and the corners common.

Then B 42° E with the S. W. line of Sur. 522 to the place
of beginning.
Since the original notes of this survey call for Sur-
veys 410 and 500, and since Surveys 500 and 600 are substan-
tially correct and the corners established in the corrected notes
for surveys the corners established in the original notes
of 600 deflected to coincide with the corners of 500 and
veys 500 and 410 were ignored and notes written to make the lines
adjacent to surveys 410 and 600 common to those surveys and
the corners common.
