

Genl Land Office Aug September 21. 1847.

Between the work on the Pedernales & the work on the Sandy there is no connection whatever although survey N^o 14 of 1 League appears to join to Survey N^o 32 of 640 acs, which is only accidental, according to an imperfect connection ^{that} which we find on Lewis' old map of Bastrop county, ^{marked} the Pedernales work is connected with some survey on Union Creek, the S. E. corner of J. P. Patterson's league N^o 14, which corner you see marked with a dot, ^(according to the new map) would fall ^{to} where you see the dot on the W. line of N. Mendy's league, and if so placed, the Cocon District line would fall so much further ^{(on the new map) to where} W. ^(to where the pencil line is drawn) ; —
The result is that the work on the Pedernales can not be ^{truly} connected with Baxter District, ^{till it is done} except by actual measurement on the ground, which is also required to give it its true position on the map of Travis District.
