

4 Leagues of land granted to Ignacio Perez situated on  
the River Medina in the Province of Coahuila (West side  
of the Medina River)

Beginning at a point on the said River, called "Barranca"  
where a Landmark was erected, Thence due West 100 Cords, - which  
is one league, to the place called "El Paso de Solares, where a Landmark  
was erected - following the measurement on the same course  
other 100 Cords to the place called the "Alto de Encinos" (the Oak  
Ridge) where a Landmark was set, following the measure on the  
same course 100 Cords, to the place called "San Simon" where a  
Landmark was erected, completing at this time to this point 4 leagues.

Thence South, along the edge of the Mesquite timber 100 Cords -  
to the Prairie called "Rosales" where a Landmark was erected as  
the end of one league.

Thence East, along the <sup>edge of the</sup> Oak timber, 100 Cords to the "Cañada  
escondida" (enclosed Ravine) where a Landmark was set,  
Continued the same course 100 Cords, which is one league, to the  
Black Oak (Jack?) Ridge (Alto de los Encinos prietos) where  
a Landmark was erected, continued same course along the  
edge of the Oak timber, and the Hill called "Padre  
Pedraza" 100 Cords, which is one league, to the Ravine <sup>of the</sup> called  
the Hill, <sup>called</sup> of San Jose where a Landmark was erected. Con-  
tinued the same course, along the margin of the said Oak  
timber 100 Cords, to the Hill called "Escondida" where a Land-  
mark was erected. Thence North, 100 Cords through the Ravine  
called "Zacate", to the "Barranca" the place of beginning.
