Dear Sir

I have the honor to inform you that at an election held at Blanco City, Blanco County, Texas on the 21st inst, to determine whether the county seat should be removed to Johnson City, or remain at Blanco, 540 votes were cast "for removal to Johnson City" and 475 votes "for remaining at Blanco City" showing a majority of 65 votes for removal to Johnson City.

The result of the election has been officially made public today and entered on the minutes of the Commissioners Court. The county officials, will move to morrow February 1st with the records of the county to Johnson City and take possession of the new courthouse.

I shall on first clear day, ascertain by Meridian altitude of sun the exact position of Johnson City, for the present I will describe it as being located near the center of South half of Survey No. 141 for James Dentress
