Attached hereto is a Certified Sketch Showing
canceled lines run in locating the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of survey
No. 82 Block No. 20 Havana Navigation company and
also the west $\frac{1}{2}$ half of same survey the sketch
shows distances and also shows by circles the
identified corners found on the ground the blue
lines are the lines run on ground I allowed these
surveys an excess of 12 varas in order to coincide with
Mr. Spillers work in Block No. 25 as he appears to
have properly identified the N. W. cor. of sur. No. 81
Blk. 20 (see his corrected notes of sur. No. 54 Blk. 25 H.R.T.C.)
he also appears to find and identify the S. W. cor. of 81
which I found well preserved he says he found the
west line of No. 81 to measure 1912 varas between the
identified corners and for that reason I allowed the
excess of 12 varas to the 2 surveys in question
