

Resurvey of the Kimball Bend Estate.

Beginning at the N.E. corner of the John Gates and S.E. corner of the Martha Baker Tracts on the Bluff of the River Brazos.

Thence S 60 W. across road leading from Village to Bend 378 paras - Joshua R. de Cordovas house bears S 72 W - a Point of Bee Mountain bears N 26 W.

at 660 paras across a Ravine

1080 paras road leading from Village to Marlborough ford

1100 paras a Stone Mound Willinghams house bears

S 56 E. and Joshua's S 64 W.

Thence same course 550 paras across road leading from Village to Joshuas

910 paras road from Village to Marlborough Green

1100 paras corner a Stone Mound from which a large Mes-

quite bears N 50 W. and Willinghams house (not a good sight) bears S 66 E.

Thence N 30 W. 275 " to the N.W. corner of Palas Cove. 492 acre survey a stone mound from which an Elm marked V by S 77 W. 74 Do W 30 W. 80

It appears that the surveyor has traced the survey on the ground up to the S.W. corner of Brinson survey, where in the last few years of the ground, following the same line of the Brinson's line, which he claims to be the corner of 492 acres survey, that he has set short 1.60 W. 352 W. N 30 W 275 W

The surveyor thinks that the N.W. cor. of 492 acres made for P. Love is out of the way, but it is more likely that the surveys south thereof are larger on the true ground as the surveyor near the compliment of their resp. field notes but fails to state that he found the lines and corners true of. It appears rather that the S.W. cor. of the 984 acre survey made for the same said P. Love is out of the way.

You will readily see how far this corner is out of the way.
