An Oak marked B bears N 26 W. 23 varas and
a Live Oak marked D bears S 60 W 53 varas

Thence S 10 W. 920 varas (the old corner tree could not be found,) planted a Stake south of a fork of Cedar
Creek from which

I did not take any Bearings
