Bro. Clark,

I went back to Bowie Co. re-run J.T. Karnes land to proper distances and corners.

I am not stuck on work over there, where the principal ingredients that form the crowd of interested and would be interested, each one of whom totes a revolver or a shot gun - & never felt right downright safe. I almost yelled at times. I had to stop arguments, listen to that fool E. Calvin shoot off his mouth, he says, The Land Office nor the state of Texas can move his lines or corners. The Bunch-Johnson, Son & Co., & Welch had a meeting before I got there and made up a fund, and put E. Calvin in as Chief Windjammer to tell you and me where to get off. He met me and began to spout & to show letters & maps etc. I told him I was there to work, and that neither he nor any one else in that country knew my business any better than I did, that he could go along, but that I would do all the necessary talking - and I got a cussing. I laughed & worked. At the N.W. cor of the D. Loving-Ella Karnes came to us, and such a dressing as ^{Calvin} Karnes and Welch got, she had her hand on her gun, Calvin shivered and tears rolled down his cheeks. "I just worked on"-

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Welch ran his Sister in law off, and gave her children away - Calvin licks his wife & cusses herowfully so I am informed. W.V. Sims say, & put the E.P. line 68 in the right place - Smelser put the S.E. 160 - 140 Va. too far west 16 years ago. he was told so then, but would not listen to reason, and Karnes says that is the reason he would not do his work. Karnes got out an injunction to stop Welch from building his fence - Welch put Mr & Miss Etta under a peace Bond - Karnes has filed suit against Calvin - Welch son. to Try Title. Welch & Calvin cannot go in borrow cash. Karnes unsecured note is good - & have my cash in full.

This letter is to you and my old friend & old Draffman.

Karnes has the cash to pay you off. (the state) So Patent him, & do not want to go back to that mid-dam country unless & have a Guard and an iron suit.

when I got to the North line of the Calvin 30 A. Tract, Ed Calvin ordered me to stay out to set no corner. - Local history says there was a P.O. blazed 4 sides for D. Loving S. W. Cor. but that E. Calvin destroyed it - so I went west to the Browning line and set Karnes S. S. W. Corner and Calvin gave you & Karnes the particular sheet.

Said I was making new notes -

I believe the surveyor who run out the A. Rennison 240 A. got balled up, got his calls gummed up - and figured out how many Sq. Va. there was in 240 A. and so put it as he did, 1.324,800 Sq. Va. and let it go - His notes will not figure 240 A. the notes I send you, I believe will - however if they do not suit you, you have my authority to change them, and get Karnes Pat. to him before some one is killed over there, as Karnes is standing over a mine - I found that the E. B. line Sec. 72 runs North, & W. B. line 68 runs N.E. that left a V. thus $\frac{69}{72} \sqrt{\frac{68}{69}}$ - so I put the N.W. Cor 68 over to N.E. cor. 72. and gained by measurement 10 Va. etw - did I do right.

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Mr Calvin when he was a welcome friend in the Karnes home, said I want to see Sec 68 corrected - now he does not. He leased 210 Acres to an Oil Co. in Sec 68, and owns 190 a. He says you cannot correct 68, that you cannot move a Pat. that the sec. line if in the wrong place now cannot be corrected. That W.J. Sims work must stand, he says his 80 in S.W. Cor 68 is shorter E & W than his deed calls for, but that he got his acreage by going farther North than his call - he says he knows the S.E. 80 is wrong. Sanders who owns it is already wanted absconding Bunker - Calvin says you cannot move his S.E. line of 80 N. of Sanders S. to cover the big vast Vacant Strip of State land - There is room for everyone and land to spare if 68 was located and sub-divided as it should be - Weaver-Sims-Smelser is the cause of it all -

Calvin is the son-in-law of Geo Son theelman in 68. who said I fixed it as I wanted to. Calvins daughter married V. Welch's son. So you can see how much chance an Honest Man like H.T. Karnes has to get and hold his land -
