I have been obliged to make this survey to
determine the location of no 91 Act 97B and any
ruling or opinion that you may favor me with
will be of great assistance in carrying my work
through successfully. I am of the opinion that Mr.

Rowley the surveyor who located these surveys
was very particular with his work on the ground,
as I find every thing according to field notes by using
courses $52\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ & $37\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ with vert. $9\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. Presumably he
had a compass with no vernier and consequently
ran all his work at the magnet, which if so considered
makes all his work check. Mr. Trible got his field
notes all right but failed to follow Mr. Rowley's line by
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ ' I think Mr. Trible's survey should be disregarded and
go solely by Rowley for the two Littles, the Thos. Spragues
and W. J. Comroe
