Herewith will please find sketch and report signed by County surveyor which I trust you will carefully inspect and oblige me with your ruling at the earliest date possible.

I have been obliged to make this survey to determine the location of no 91 Act 413 and any ruling or opinion that you may favor me with will be of great assistance in carrying my work through successfully. I am of the opinion that Mr Rowley the surveyor who located these surveys was very particular with his work on the ground, as I find every thing according to field notes by using courses $52\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ & $37\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ with var. $9\frac{1}{2}'$ E. Presumably he had a compass with no vernier and consequently run all his work at the magnet, which if so considered makes all his work check. Mr Fribble got his field notes all right but failed to follow Mr Rowley's line by 1015'. I think Mr Fribble's survey should be disregarded and go solely by Rowley for the two Littles, The Thos Spraggins and W. J. Courou.
