and the E. corner of the J.C. Bartlett survey,
from which a double Bois d'arc 4 inches dia.
mkd & bears S. 59½° W. 103 varas; thence
N. 75° W. at 747 varas enter pond, at 1200 varas
a stake for corner; thence N. 50° 04' E. at
80 varas leave pond - At 620 varas cross
creek; at 5057 varas find post set for
corner, on the bank of Bastrop Bay; thence
