

Field notes of a survey of 4,972,195 square varas of land, made to determine the most feasible position of the Henry Austin 4 1/2 Labor Survey, in Brazoria County - Texas -

Beginning at a Cedar stake, set at the mouth of a small creek on Oyster Bay, the S.E. corner of said Henry Austin survey, and the E. corner of the J. C. Bartlett survey, from which a double Bois d'Arc 4 inches in dia. mkd X bears S. 59 1/2° N. 103 varas; thence N. 75° N. at 747 varas, enter pond, at 1200 varas a stake for corner; thence N. 50° 04' E. at 80 varas leave pond - at 620 varas cross creek; at 5057 varas find post set for corner, on the bank of Bastrop Bay; thence along the shore of Bastrop Bay.
