Field notes of a survey of 260.5 acres of land made for Albert Fedder by virtue of his application for the right to prospect for oil or gas on the unsurveyed public land of the state, made and filed with the county surveyor of Brazoria County, Texas, on the 7th day of June, 1917, under Section 4, Chapter 173, Act approved April 9th , 1913.

Said survey is situated in Brazoria County, Texas, about 18 miles Southeast from the county seat, and is bounded as follows:

Beginning at an iran pipe and stake on The east end of (2993) Tidlam Tadlam Island on the south side of Tidlam Tadlam Bayou from which the beginning point for the survey of Mud Island bears North 100 varas;

Thence with the meanders of the south bank of said Tidlam Tadlam Bayou as follows:

N 13°30'W 268 vrs., N 28°W 300 vrs., N 60°W 217 vrs., S 58°30'W 276 vrs., S72°W 97 vrs., to an iron pipe and two white stakes on the south bank of said bayou.

Thence across said Tidlam Tadlam Island as follow: S 21°W 258 varas to an iron pipe and stake on the south bank of said island.

Thence with the meanders of said bank of said island as foldows:
