and that he is a Married man and entitled to one league and labor

of land upon condition of paying at the rate of Three Dollars and fifty Cents

for each labor of Irrigable land Two Dollars and fifty Cents

for each labor of Temporal or arable land One Dollar and twenty Cents

for every labor of Pasture land which may be contained in the survey secured to him

by this Certificate.

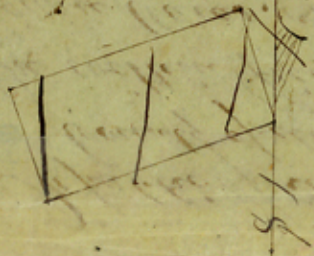
