Finds that these proceedings have been conducted according to law, that this Court has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter and that the said State of Texas was the sole owner on the date of taking of Tract Nos. 209E-1, 305E-1, 404E-1, 404E-2, 506E-1, 506E-2, 507E-1, 507E-2, 702E-1, 703E-1, 703E-2, 704E-1, 704E-2, 812E-1, 812E-2 and 1008E-1 and is entitled to the compensation therefor.

That on the date of the filing of the Declaration of Taking, the sum of \$5,475.00 was deposited into the registry of the Court for the benefit of the persons entitled thereto as estimated just compensation for the taking of said interests in real property.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that the just compensation which the United States of America shall pay for the taking of the real estate described in the Declaration of Taking herein as Tract Nos. 209E-1, 305E-1, 404E-1, 404E-2, 506E-1, 506E-2, 507E-1, 507E-2, 702E-1, 703E-1, 703E-2, 704E-1, 704E-2, 812E-1, 812E-2 and 1008E-1 is the sum of TEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS(§10,000.00), inclusive of interest, and

That the legal description of Tract No. 704E-1, as set forth in Schedule "B" of the Complaint in Condemnation and the Declaration of Taking filed herein, shall be deleted therefrom and the revised legal description of Tract No. 704E-1 attached as Exhibit "A" shall be substituted in lieu thereof, and

That the plat of Tract No. 704E-1, as set forth in Schedule "C" of the Complaint in Condemnation and the Declaration of Taking filed herein, shall be deleted therefrom and the revised plat of Tract No. 704E-1 attached as Exhibit "B" shall be substituted in lieu thereof.

It is further ORDERED that the United States of America shall pay into the registry of the Court the sum of \$4,525.00, and that the clerk shall disburse said sum, together with \$5,475.00 now on deposit in the registry of the Court, together with any interest heretofore earned on the deposit, to the said State of Texas at its address:
