

The last section of the Texas Panhandle, the Llano Estacado, or Staked Plain, is a great prairie extending from the Red River to the Pecos River, and from the Colorado River to the Rio Grande. It is a level plain, with no surface drainage, and is covered with a thin soil, derived from the weathering of the underlying limestone. The soil is very poor, and is easily washed away by rain. The climate is dry and hot, with little rainfall. The vegetation consists mainly of grasses, such as grama, bluestem, and switchgrass, which grow in patches. There are also some shrubs, such as mesquite and saltgrass. The animals found here include the bison, pronghorn antelope, mule deer, and various species of small mammals.
