Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of April 19, 1966 concerning your problem in locating proper corners for Sec. 110, Block G-5, and Sections 108 and 112, Block 341, Presidio County, Texas.

An examination of the records of the land office reveals that Sec. 110, Block 6-5 is patented on the field notes of John T. Gano calling for rock mound corners without benefit of witness calls. Sections 108 and 112, Block 341 were surveyed by S. A. Thompson but also call for rock mounds only.

Mr. J. T. Carney, Jr., Licensed State Land Surveyor and County Surveyor of Brewster County, identified and reestablished the SW corner of Sec. 52, Block G-12 in 1955, which corner is also the SE corner of Sec. 105, TC Ry. Co., Block 341. It is very likely that Mr. Carney can help you in this problem.

The records of this office are always available for examination and copies can be had for nominal fees; however, the actual interpretation of the various instruments is left to the examining surveyor who alone is conversant with his particular problem in the field.

If, upon completion of a survey, the surveyor submits his maps, reports or field notes to the General Land Office for filing, the personnel of the engineering division and the legal examiners will be available to assist him as needed.
